Background

Wycombe High School is a girls' grammar school in High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire. It is an Academy, taking girls from the age of 11 through to the age of 18. The school has approximately 1,340 pupils, and became an Academy in 2011.

In September 2005, the Department for Education and Skills (DfES) awarded the school specialist school status in Mathematics & Computing.

A Need For Change

Connectivity plays a pivotal role in learning, especially distance learning. With a diverse, legacy connectivity infrastructure the school needed to rationalise multiple ADSL connections, build in more resilience and make savings on line rental costs.

The school also wanted greater operational flexibility in the way data was handled, together with the extra resilience that comes from being able to instantly reroute traffic, for example power outages.

The Contenders

Many different options were discussed with WHS, but it became quickly apparent that due to the large data needs that a Leased Line was the only contender.

The Result

A 1000mb / 1000mb Leased Line installed within 2 months which greatly increased the schools ability to keep up with the ever increasing demand by pupil's consumption of data through cloud based services.
